15th Swimming Carnival (only for P4 to P6 students)

7. Our 15th Swimming Carnival will be held on Tuesday, 7 August at the Clementi Swimming Complex. The event will involve only the P4 to P6 levels and students will need to report to school by 7.25 am. All P1 to P3 students **need not** report to school on that day. They will take part in the upcoming PAM Carnival in October. Our Swimming Carnival caters to students of various swimming competencies. The strong swimmers will be able to compete in races such as the 50 metres Breaststroke and Freestyle. We will also be organising exciting water games such as Flippa Ball (a game similar to water polo) and Water Fun (with activities such as lifejacket relay, pool treasure hunt, clearing of water obstacle course and simple water play). The water games will be played in the 0.9 metre deep training pool and 0.3 metre deep wading pool. Our Guest-of-Honour for the event will be former Singapore Water Polo player, Mr Paul Tan. Mr Tan was an outstanding athlete when he was a student, and he represented Singapore in several Asian and South-East Asian Games.

National Day Celebration

8. On Wednesday, 8 August, we will be celebrating Singapore's 53rd birthday. On that day, all students will report to school as usual at 7.30 am and school will be dismissed at 10 am. Students are encouraged to be dressed in red T-shirts and school shorts/ skorts/ skirts with white socks and school shoes. All after-school activities such as supplementary/remedial classes and CCAs on that afternoon will be cancelled. 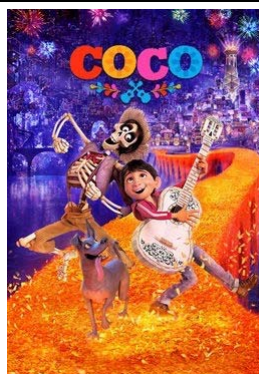
