Upcoming Events

Teachers' Day (4 September)

7. QtPS will be celebrating Teachers' Day on Thursday, 4 September. As part of the celebration, students will be dismissed at 10.30 am on Thursday, 4 September. This will be the last school day of Term 3.

Primary 6 students **do not need** to report to school. Subject teachers will arrange virtual consultation sessions with the students. More details will be communicated closer to the dates.

PSLE Written Examinations (25 September to 1 October)

13. The PSLE written papers will be held from Thursday, 25 September to Wednesday, 1 October. P6 students will be given separate instructions on their reporting times and examination procedures. P1 to P5 students will come to school for lessons as per normal. We wish all our P6 students all the best in the upcoming PSLE. Onward to Success!
